Day 1 - Depart for Holy Land

Today: Depart for Tel Aviv with complimentary meals and beverages served onboard your international flight.

Day 2 - Arrival to Tel-Aviv Airport

Today: On arrival in Tel Aviv proceed through Passport Control, meet our private airport assistant, and claim our luggage. Our group will meet straight forward with our guide.
Evening: Proceed to our hotel in Nazareth

Day 3 - Mt. Tabor - Cana - Nazareth

Today: Drive to Mount Tabor (The site of the Transfiguration) and then to Cana of Galilee to visit the wedding Church (Mass) where Jesus performed the first of his signs, changing water to wine. Continue drive to Nazareth and visit the Basilica of the Annunciation starting with the Grotto of the Annunciation and the Church then we will visit the house of the Holy Family underneath the Church of St. Joseph. Meeting with Vicar of Nazareth.
Evening: Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Nazareth

Day 4 - Tiberias - Sea of Galilee - Capernaum - Mt. of Beatitudes

Today: This morning, we drive to the Sea of Galilee to visit the Mt. of Beatitudes where our Lord gave the Sermon on the Mount (Mass) continue to Tabgha to see the splendid mosaic of the loaves and fishes with which he feed the Five Thousand. Visit the Church of St. Peter's Primacy and then go to visit Capernaum to see the house of St. Peter and the Synagogue where our Lord preached. You will have the opportunity to try the St. Peter's fish for lunch today. One of today's highlights is a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee and we will also see the "Jesus Boat" a 2000 year old boat found at the shores of Magdala.
Evening: Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Nazareth

Day 5 - Haifa - Caesarea

Today: This Morning, we will drive to Haifa and go on Mt. Carmel where The Carmelites started 900 years ago. We celebrate Mass at the church of Stella Maris, "the star of the sea". We will have a panoramic view of the city Haifa and the beautiful Baha'i Gardens. We drive west to Caesarea Maritime, where St. Peter Baptized Cornelius and St. Paul was a prisoner for a while before going to Rome. Here we visit the Roman Aqueducts and the Roman Theater and the palace of Pontius Pilate. Then, we continue to Nazareth to enjoy a free afternoon.
Evening: Dinner and Overnight in Nazareth

Day 6 - Samaria - Nablus - Taybeh - Dead Sea - Jericho

Today: After breakfast, you will drive along the Jordan Valley to Samaria, starting with visit to the Parish of Rafidia and celebrate Mass. Continue to Nablus to visit Jacob's well. Continue to Taybeh where Jesus, after Lazarus' resurrection, retired with his disciples to this town. Visit the Taybeh Beer Factory, which produces a premium high quality hand crafted beer contributing to the Palestinian economy. Time for Lunch. We will drive south to Dead Sea, will spend the afternoon on the beach for a swim (or rather a float!) in the mineral rich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties.
Evening: Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Jericho Resort for one night.

Day 7 - Jericho - Qumran - Jerusalem

Today: After breakfast, we visit the oasis town of Jericho, see the oldest city in the world and view Mt. Temptation where Jesus fasted and was tempted by Satan. Then we will drive along



the Jordan Valley. Visit the Jordan River to renew our baptism vows. We will continue our drive to Masada and take the cable car ride up to the top. Afterward, we drive to Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were uncovered and visit the excavation site. Celebrate Mass at Good Shepherd a local parish.
Evening: Drive to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Rosary Sister Guesthouse for the next 5 nights.

Day 8 - Bethlehem - Ain Karem - Jerusalem

Today: This morning, we Drive to Bethlehem visiting the place of birth of our Lord, The Basilica of the Nativity. We will visit the Grotto of Nativity and the Church of St. Catherine where the Midnight Mass is celebrated and the Caves of St. Joseph and St. Jerome underneath the church. Visit Shepherd's Fields, where the Angels appeared to the shepherds who were watching over their flocks during the night. In the afternoon, we drive to Ain Karem to visit the birth place of St. John the Baptist and the Church of the Visitation where Mary came to visit her kinswoman Elizabeth and proclaimed the 'Magnificat'. (Holy Mass at the Nativity Church)
Evening: Dinner and overnight at the Rosary Sisters Guest House

Day 9 - Mount Zion - Upper Room- Jerusalem

In the morning, we go to Mount Zion to visit the Church of the Dormition commemorating our Blessed Mother falling asleep. Next, we go to visit the Cenacle /Upper Room, the place of the Last Supper and Pentecost. We also visit the Church of Saint Peter in Gallicantu. The house of the high priest of the Jews, Caiaphas, where Jesus was imprisoned for the night and where Peter denied our Lord. Mass at the Latin Patriarchate Cathedral. (Visit of the Latin Patriarchate and meeting with the Patriarch).
Evening: Dinner and overnight at the Rosary Sisters Guest House

Day 10 - Jerusalem - The Passion of Jesus' last hours

Today: We enter the Old city Jerusalem to visit the Dome of the Rock and El-Aqsa Mosque and the Western Wall and the Jewish quarter and the Cardo. After Lunch, we will transfer to St. Anna Church for the visit of the Pool of Betesda. We continue to the Judgment Hall known as the Antonia Fortress where Jesus was led to be condemned to death by Pontius Pilate. At this place, we start walking the Via Dolorosa through the markets of the Old City praying the Stations of the Cross, we reflect on the greatness of His sacrifice, stopping at each of the fourteen stations of the cross until we reach the Church of Holy Sepulcher. Visit Calvary and the empty Tomb of our Lord and the different sections of the church. Holy Mass in the Holy Sepulchre.
Evening: Dinner and overnight at the Rosary Sisters Guest House

Day 11 - Jerusalem - Mt. Of Olives

Today: After breakfast, we drive to the top of Mt. Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem for a better understanding of its geography and some of the key sites surrounding the area. Visit the Church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught his disciples how to pray, and then we walk on the Palm Sunday road to the church of Dominus Fleuit, where our Lord wept over the city. Continue our walk on the Palm Sunday road to the Garden of Gethsemane. At Gethsemane is the Rock of Agony where Jesus uttered his last prayer. Spend some time in reflection and meditation inside the church. (Holy Mass in the Garden of Gethsemane)
Evening: Dinner and overnight at the Rosary Sisters Guest House

Day 12 - Back to USA

Today: In the morning, we departure from Telaviv and flight back to the Usa.
